The Byzantine Empire was the heir to two great cultures that cradled and nurtured European civilization: Greece and Rome. Constantinople, now called Istanbul, became a center of power, culture, trade, and technology poised on the edges of Europe and Asia, and its influence was felt not only throughout Europe but the Middle East, Africa, Central Asia, and the Far East. Coins dating from the reign of Emperor Justinian I (r.527-565) have been found in southern India, and Chinese records show that the "Fulin," as the Chinese named the Byzantines, were received at court as early as 643 CE. For a thousand years, the Byzantine Empire protected Europe from the Islamic Arab Empire, allowing it to pursue its own destiny. Finally, Byzantium was a polyglot society in which a multitude of ethnic groups lived under the emperor prizing peace above war, an inspiration surely for the modern age

when divisive nationalism threatens to dominate society once more. Despite all this, the Byzantine Empire is often treated as a medieval oddity, an absolute state stunted by a myopic religion, a corrupt, labyrinthine bureaucracy, and an inability to adapt to change. In truth, none of these judgments bear any serious scrutiny - Byzantium was a strong, organized, highly effective and adaptable civilization for most of its long history. It owed its success in no small part to its military, which, in contrast to the feudal armies of Western Europe and the tribally based forces of the Middle East, operated with a high level of discipline, strategic prowess, efficiency, and organization. At the same time, the Byzantines relied heavily on mercenaries, and the *Hetairoi* or foreign soldiers formed an important and often vital component of the army. The ability to call upon warriors from many nations demonstrated the power and wealth of the emperor, so they were recruited as much for prestige as for military utility. The most famous of the foreign units was without question the Varangian Guard. The Varangians came from the land in Eastern Europe known in the Middle Ages as Rus, which is now part of modern Russia and Ukraine. They were descendants of Viking warriors from Sweden who came to rule the waterways and population of Russia. Varangian mercenaries were fighting for the Byzantines by the 10th century, and in 988 they formed a permanent elite guard for the emperor. They took an oath of allegiance to him and served directly under the *Acolyte* or *Akolouthos*, who was usually of Byzantine origin. They also assumed responsibilities for the security of Constantinople. They served in battles outside the capital, but usually only when necessity called for it. The Varangian Guard's primary duty was always to protect the emperor, and inevitably, the Varangians became a political force, taking part in the numerous palace coups. They displayed a fierce devotion not necessarily to the emperor but to the throne itself - for example, when Emperor Nicephorus II was murdered by John I Tzimiskes in 969, the Varangian Guard immediately pledged its allegiance to the usurper. The Varangian Guard consisted of heavily armored infantry bearing shields, heavy swords, and Norse battle axes, either single-bladed or double-bladed. They were amongst the fiercest and most feared military units in Christendom, which made the unit an attractive station for many soldiers of fortune who came to Constantinople hoping to pursue lucrative military careers in the service of the Byzantine emperors. Those from the West were called at various times *Frankoi*, (Franks), *Latinoi* (Latins, i.e. Latin Rite Christians), or Normans. Frankish knights were often hired to combat the Turks in the 11th century. The Praetorian Guard of Imperial Rome was the power behind the throne, with the ability to make or break an emperor. As the main body of troops in Rome, they were the emperor's instrument to discourage plotting and rebellion and to crush unrest. THE IMALT-WOR: The notorious strong arms of the king, they maintain his law across the land. They are highly disciplined, respected and feared. Hinego is as strict in his personal life as he is maintaining the king's law. He has no time or patience for careless wastrels. Forced to work together to locate the king's missing niece, neither man sees the journey ending in anything but disaster. From betrayal and pain, can two very different worlds be saved? A naive beauty... Olivia has never questioned the teachings of the Witches Guild, never questioned the Elders; it's the only life she's ever known. An uncontrollable hunger... Ristan has spent centuries trying to contain his true nature, restraining his Demon and its voracious hunger for souls. A situation neither of them were prepared for. They say the road to Hell is paved with good intentions, and Olivia can't escape from her actions. What she's done, she knows must be paid for in blood. Her own. A monstrous need for revenge against the girl who wronged him; Ristan wants to keep her, humiliate and torment her, but his inability to truly harm her may just be his undoing. A dangerous need to explore the man who holds her captive and captivated; Olivia knows she should run, or resist him, but the magnetic pull he has on her is undeniable." "Myah has been betrayed. Nordlin City lie in flame, destroyed by the Osten Army, and her greatest nightmare has become her greatest sorrow. To avoid capture, Myah has no choice but to trust the master of the Osten Elite Guard to protect her and keep her out of the hands of her enemy and his people. However, trust is a fragile thing, easily fractured when her companion keeps his secrets as close as his steel, and Garrett's reputation is not one that is easily dismissed. Garrett's secrets have kept him and those he loves safe for years. To reveal one is to unravel them all, and the fire-haired girl of the north has a way of plucking at those threads. A promise is a promise, though, and he gave his word to see her safely to the resistance leader hiding at the edges of Morgensol, the southern kingdom. But as she has put her trust him, he knows that he will have to do the same if he wants to regain the most precious thing he has lost in the kingdom wars" -- The Waffen-SS was the elite military force of Germany, the most loyal soldiers of the Third Reich. Their elitism came from their unique special traits that emerged when compared to the other German armed forces. Their sharp uniforms, precision drilling, and the strict enlistment qualifications established the Waffen-SS an elite. Later, it would be combat during wartime that would establish the SS units worldwide as an elite. This thesis provides an explanation of why men were motivated to volunteer and serve in the Waffen-SS. In addition to exploring the mentality of the Waffen-SS men, this thesis also describes the Waffen-SS's role in German society as an evolutionary experience, from a political organization to a military power. Men joined for a number of reasons, including the attractive uniforms, the desire to serve Hitler, anti-Bolshevism, the desire to be part of an elite organization, better pay, and as the war took its toll on civilization, food. As the war inflicted massive amounts of casualties on the unit, the Waffen-SS was forced to use foreign volunteers and conscripts. Also, the casualties created a generational rift among German families; sincere disdain for the Waffen branch amongst the older generation conflicted with the youth of Germany, as the youth were willing to eagerly fight and volunteer for the SS as the war dragged on. By the end of the war, Hitler himself embraced the elitism surrounding the Waffen-SS, as the army had lost face in his eyes due to the defeats on the Eastern Front.
