On the basis of the results obtained from previous nondestructive kinetic tests, an analysis was made to determine the nature of the results to be expected for an assumed 1.8-sec-period test in which total core destruction occurs. An evaluation of hazards involved in conducting the 1.8-msec test, based on conservative assumptions regarding fission product release and weather conditions, indicated that with the procedural controls normally exercised in the conduct of any transient test at Spert and the special controls to be in effect during the destructive test series, no significant hazard to personnel or to the general public will be incurred.
